And there you have it! These are the 145 amazing boards that I have found in publicly accessible areas throughout Temuair. I have not included boards of Medenia in this work as I have not spent time there, although I would like to give a shoutout to the boards in the Mileth Fair as well as the boards in publicly-inaccessible areas such as the Mileth and Rucesion commons. Because these are areas that are not universally accessible at all times, I have chosen to leave them out of my records, though I highly recommend checking them out if you can! Every board is beautiful, and a secret sign is all the more alluring.
